- You are the God who hears when I call (1).
- You are the God of my righteousness (1).
- You are the God who has given me relief in all my distresses (1).
- You are the God who has mercy on me (1).
- You are the God who receives my prayers (1).
- You are the God who is concerned about what people say about me and do to me (2).
- You are the God who is for me even though people may be against me (3).
- You are the God who has set me apart for Yourself (3).
- You are the God who has made me Your special possession (3).
- You are the God who has determined to listen to me (3).
- Rebellion against You is an insult to You and must be avoided at all costs (4).
- You are the holy God who must be listened to (4).
- You are the righteous God which men must consider and surrender to (4).
- You are the God who is worthy of sacrifice (5).
- You are the God who is to be trusted (5).
- You are the God who gives what is good and holy in all circumstances (6).
- You are the God who grants us Your presence (6).
- You are the God who puts gladness in my heart (7).
- You are the God who gives me greater joy than anything that the world offers (7).
- You are the God who offers genuine joy (7).
- You are the God who makes me lie down in peace and sleep (8).
- You are the God who alone makes me to dwell in safety (8).
- You are the God who I can depend on to sustain me (8).
- You are the God who lets me rest in all the circumstances of life (8).
