

The Praying Parent

God has not called you to be a perfect parent. Yet, He has called you to be a praying parent. The greatest thing that you can do for your child is to pray for him or her. You can make a positive and lasting impact on your child through prayer. At every stage of their lives, your children need and will greatly benefit from your prayers.

You can turn to the expert Parent, your heavenly Father. When you do this, you are inviting His presence and power into his or her life. When you pray for your child, you are asking God to make His presence and power a part of his or her life. You are asking God to powerfully work in his or her life. That does mean that there will always be an immediate answer to your prayers. Sometimes it can take days, weeks, months, or even years. Yet, if you are praying something is happening, whether you see it or not. The Word of God says, "The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much *(James 5:16)*.
