NITTY-GRITTY PRAYING FOR THE LOST

When *The Prayer Closet* began in 1998, one of my burdens was to encourage and equip believers to pray for people who need Jesus. It has burdened me that believers and churches do not spend time interceding for the lost. We will quickly pray for people who need healing or who have had loved ones die. Yet, we seem hesitant, almost unconcerned, to pray for the lost, whether in our community or across the world.

God will and does honor praying for people who need Jesus. It is a part of His way of saving sinners. I want to challenge you to pray for the lost around you. I would encourage you to make a list of people that you know need Jesus. The following are Scripture prayers to help you. They are based on the three basic truths of the gospel: the condition of the sinner, who Jesus is, and faith and repentance. I have used these myself and have taught them to many others.

You can use these or develop others from them. I would urge you to pray by name for people with these. At the same time, you might consider placing "the lost of this area" in your prayers. The key is to plead the truth of God's Word over those who are outside of Christ and in danger of everlasting condemnation.

I pray that will know with deep and abiding conviction that he/she has broken God's law and stands guilty before Him even at this moment (I John 3:4). Father, I ask You to convict of the truth that they he/she is in rebellion against You. Show that without faith in Christ, there is no peace between You and him. Reveal to that his/her lifestyle is actually rebellion and a sign of hostility against You (Romans 5:1; James 4:4).

We began publishing *The Prayer Closet* newsletter in February of 1998. It was originally started to encourage those who prayed for my itinerant, evangelistic ministry. At the prompting of others, we expanded it to anyone who wanted it. Our first mailing of the newsletter was to 26 people. It has grown in circulation now, going into every state in the United States and over 50 foreign countries. It has truly been the hand of God. I give all the credit and glory to God.

During these 23 years, we have experienced many changes. We have had board members come on and rotate off. We've had a number of volunteers come and go. We started out in a board member's living room to a house donated to us and now to our facility outside of Hickory. We've had time of great blessing and times when I had no idea how we could continue. We've experienced and weathered some of the fiercest attacks of the enemy that I've ever seen.

At this time, we stand at the brink of another change. This is something that I've wrestled with, prayed about, and wept over. The time has come that we are going to end the hard copy issue of *The Prayer Closet*. The Prayer Closet newsletter will still be available by email. It can be downloaded at our website prayerclosetministries.org.

Please realize that this is not the end of *The Prayer Closet* newsletter. It will still be published. It will still be available by email or download. This has been a hard decision. The health of my staff has declined and it has become increasingly harder to put out the hard copy. Moreover, at the same time, we want to put more emphasis and resources into our website and facility. We are looking to expand the website and offer more prayer guides and helps for believers and churches. We are also working on a podcast called The Prayer Closet. This podcast will focus on teaching believers and churches how to pray, fast, and seek God for revival. I'll be doing interviews and book reviews too.

At this point, we plan to publish two more hard copy newsletters - this one and one for November-January. In February of 2020, the newsletter will be available bimonthly through email and download at our website.
